I took this photograph of a yacht sailing towards Poole harbour as the sun was disappearing behind

the trees from Haven point where the chain ferry crosses from Sandbanks to Studland.

It was only the other evening when I was looking at the photo again that I remembered that my father and I had sailed this stretch of water into Poole harbour mooring at the quayside over fifty years ago. We had left Yarmouth on the Isle of Wight that morning and sailed directly to Poole, arriving late afternoon. My dad was a keen dinghy sailor and had hired a small yacht from Lymington for two weeks so we could sail along the south coast. It was probably madness as to the best of my knowledge he had no prior experience of sailing at sea or coastal navigation but we survived. Photographs capture moments in time evoking memories long forgotten as is the case with this image for me, I hope you like it.
